Dates

Next date for Winter Term 2023-2024 to begin is 01/10/2023.

Application portfolios can be submitted at all times until 15/09/2023 by 4.00 pm. Early application is recommended.

Applicants who have not yet com-pleted their high school leaving exams can already apply with transcripts from grades 12.1, 13.1 (or 11.1 from AP or "accelerated studies").

Applicants with a technical college entrance qualification or high school degree and / or relevant vocational training may enter at a higher level or shorten the duration of their studies after passing an aptitude test.

Application requirements

The following application requirements apply to all applicants to the Communication Design degree track:

- General qualification for university entrance (Abitur) or
- University of applied sciences entrance qualification or
- Secondary school or comparable school degree

Non-native applicants need to proove their language competences at the end of the 3rd Semester by presenting a proof of language skills of level B2.

Portfolio

The (digital) portfolio should contain at least 10 - 20 examples of work. These may include: Drawings, collages, photographs, paintings on canvas, applied work, video works. For three-dimensional work, please attach photos.

It is important that submitted works reflect your creative ability and creativity. In addition, a personal interview with the admission committee decides on your admission.

The portfolio has to be marked from the outside with your name, address and telephone number. If you submit the portfolio by upload please name it with your full name.

The decision about your acceptance wil be announced within 2 weeks.
